Writing formulas

- Always start with =
- Copying and pasting formulas
- Absolute vs. relative references

Functions

Functions are built-in operations that calculate a value based on a range of cells.

- = SUM(cell1:cell2)
- = AVERAGE (cell1:cell2)
- = COUNT (cell1:cell2)
- = IF (logical test, value if true, value if false)
- = COUNTIF (range, criteria)

Other useful tips

- Insert row(s) or column(s)
- Sorting Data tab
- Fill down (ctrl-d), fill right (ctrl-r)
- Different sheets (tabs)
- Renaming sheets
- Check out the finance-related templates.
