- Automatically sync all
  - o Note: In general, deleting in one place will delete everywhere.
  - iPhone iCloud
    - To turn on, go to Settings > [your name] > iCloud > Photos, then turn on iCloud Photos
    - To access, go to icloud.com and go to Photos
  - Android Google Photos
    - To turn on, go to Google Photos app  $\rightarrow$  menus  $\longrightarrow$  Settings  $\rightarrow$  Back up & sync  $\rightarrow$  On
    - To access, go to photos.google.com
    - In Settings, you have an option to remove photos from your device that are already backed up.)

#### Removing apps

- Apple
  - o Touch and hold any app until they all jiggle
  - o Tap X to remove an app
- Android

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○ Settings  $\rightarrow$  Apps & notif  $\rightarrow$  Tap app  $\rightarrow$  Uninstall

or

 $\circ$  Touch and hold any app  $\rightarrow$  Drag up to Uninstall

### **Organizing your apps**

- Put your most used apps in the dock (bottom of home screen)
- Put your next most used apps on the home page
- Use folders to group common apps, e.g. games or reference
  - o To create a folder, drag one app on top of another
- Get rid of apps you never use
- Review Home settings (Android)
